A Swedish driver has received a world record million-dollar speeding fine for driving at nearly 300 kph. The 37-year-old Swede was in his Mercedes super car when police in Switzerland stopped him. A traffic policeman said he was going so fast he needed 500 metres to stop. Courts fined him 1,080,000 Swiss francs, which is just over one million dollars. His car is worth almost a quarter of the fine, at \$234,000. The driver joked about his speed when the police stopped him. He said: "I think the speedo on the car is faulty."

Driving at high speeds on roads is crazy. People don't understand that the car becomes a deadly weapon. People will die if there is an accident. Many drivers think they won't crash. They think they are good drivers and nothing will happen to them. However, the best drivers in the world cannot stop quickly when they are driving too fast. Most governments don't do enough about speeding. People who speed are criminals. They break the law every time they go over the speed limit, and sometimes they kill others.
