The American state of Utah has chosen a new symbol – a gun. Utah becomes the first American state to have an official firearm. The new addition to Utah's state symbols is the Browning M1911 pistol. It was designed by Utah native John Browning. In 1911, it became the standard gun given to all American soldiers. It is still used by some of America's elite military units. A state spokeswoman said: "This bill isn't so much about a weapon as it is about honoring John Browning, who was a Utah inventor and entrepreneur."

The new law is unpopular with many Utah residents. Critics say the new state symbol sends a message that gun violence is OK. Democratic politician Brian King voted against the bill. He said: "When we are talking about a state symbol, we would do well to come up with one that is more unifying than divisive...This is just a poor choice for a state symbol." Republican Carl Wimmer defended the choice of the Browning M1911. He said it represented freedom, not death.
