Unilever also looked at people's showering habits – what they do in the shower. They discovered that the average shower lasted eight minutes. Energy expert Dr Paula Owen advised people to take four-minute showers to save water and electricity. She said it was important people understand that showers waste more water and energy than baths. "People always consider the running costs of cars and phones, but no-one considers the...costs of everyday appliances such as showers, washing machines and TVs," she said.
